All of these traits enable Agnieszka to handle both people and unexpected situations very well, from German bus drivers going the wrong way down one-way streets in Budapest to American choral conductors putting the final touches on a successful tour. In sum, Agnieszka is everything one could want in a guide, courier, or friend; anyone who engages her in any of those roles will be fortunate, indeed.
